Drivers will count Best 4 of 5 Events

#### Optional/Additional Classes:

TaG Legend, TaG Junior. Any additional classes that are geographically strong in certain areas, OR any classes that are offered at the above mentioned tracks, that aren't included in the Class Structure.

#### Race Format:

Events will run a full day of practice on Friday, with straight up points format for classes on both Saturday and Sunday. Same classes will run both days, same format, Qualifying, Heat & Main. Gold Speed will maintain overall points per event, utilizing as simple a formula as possible. Winners of each class will receive 50 points. Classes that have 10 or more entries will receive 10 Bonus points to that weekend's respective class winner and participants. Drivers competing in all 5 events will be allowed to drop 1 race.

#### Points Formula per Race Day:

1<sup>st</sup>: 50 pts

2<sup>nd</sup>: 49

3<sup>rd</sup>: 48

4<sup>th</sup>: 47

5<sup>th</sup>: 46

6<sup>th</sup>: 45

7<sup>th</sup>: 44

8<sup>th</sup>: 43

9<sup>th</sup>: 42

10<sup>th</sup>: 41

11<sup>th</sup> on back will be also be a 1 point breakdown, thus keeping points tight all season long, further giving drivers incentive to run all 5 events.

#### Bonus Points:

1 Bonus Point for Fast Qualifier.

1 Bonus Point for winning Heat

1 Bonus Point for winning Main

### 25 Bonus Points for a driver who competes in all 5 Races

2 Rounds of Practice, Qualifying, Heat Race, Main. Each day  
Top 3 receive Awards. Winner to receive Trophy, along with Winners Hat.  
2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> to receive plaques.

Competitors will have a chance to receive a free set of tires per class,  
through a drawing at each Drivers Meeting.

Sponsorship for classes is \$1,000 per class. Sponsorship will carry through all 5 races, as well as the  
Grand National event. Funds from the Sponsorship will go towards the Year End Merchandise at Grand  
National Event.

**Requirements:**

In order for drivers to be eligible for Year End Championship Awards, they must participate in at least 4  
of the 5 events.

Grand National Event is open to ALL participants, whether they competed in the Maxxis program or not.  
Drivers must be running on Maxxis Tires in events that count towards the Year End Title.

Drivers can practice on new or used Maxxis tires, but must come to the grid for qualifying with NEW  
Maxxis Tires. Tires to be qualified on will be required to be run on said kart in main events.

**Note: The above mentioned Tire Rule does NOT apply to Local Option Classes or Vintage Karts.**

**National Class Entry Fees:**

Pre Entry: \$75

At Track: \$80

**Kid Kart and Local Option Class Fees:**

Pre Entry: \$30

At Track: \$35

Practice Fees: \$50. 1-time fee, no matter how many classes a driver chooses to compete in.

**Awards/Merchandise:**

The Jacksonville Grand National will provide merchandise to all participants, regulars or newcomers to  
the program.

**Year End Awards:**

Top 3 in each class will be honored at Year End Awards Presentation, location to be determined.

Champions to receive Championship Trophy, Jacket, Hat, and set of tires.

2<sup>nd</sup> place to receive a trophy and pair of tires,

3<sup>rd</sup> place receiving trophy and free entry to 1 event in the following year.
