The first Team Endurance Race Day is coming on June 26<sup>th</sup>. Start thinking about who you might be able to team-up with. For the SH50 and SH100 races, riders or teams can sign-up and race in both events, as long as the motorcycle is legal for the specific class (Youth 50 for the SH50 and Youth 110 for the SH100). Pre-entry for the event is open to get a starting spot reserved only. There are limits to the number of teams that can enter, so we suggest getting your spot reserved early.
